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



3. PLANET-WIDE FLOODING GENESIS 7:17-24

And the **flood** was **forty** days upon the earth; and the waters **increased**, and bare up the ark, and it was lift up above the earth. And the waters prevailed, and were increased areatly upon the earth; and the ark went upon the face of the waters. And the waters prevailed exceedingly upon the earth; and all the high hills, that were under the whole heaven, were **covered**. Fifteen cubits upward did the waters prevail; and the mountains were covered. And all flesh **died** that moved upon the earth, both of fowl, and of cattle, and of beast, and of every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth, and every man: All in whose nostrils was the breath of life, of all that was in the dry land, died. And every living substance was destroyed which was upon the face of the ground, both man, and cattle, and the creeping things, and the fowl of the heaven; and they were destroyed from the earth: and **Noah** only remained **alive**, and they that were with him in the ark. And the waters prevailed upon the **earth** an hundred and fifty days.



4. THE RAVEN AND THE DOVE GENESIS 8:6-12

And it came to pass at the end of forty days, that Noah **opened** the **window** of the **ark** which he had made: And he sent forth a **raven**, which went forth to and fro, until the **waters** were dried up from off the earth. Also he sent forth a dove from him, to see if the waters were abated from off the face of the ground; But the dove found no rest for the sole of her foot, and she returned unto him into the ark, for the waters were on the face of the whole earth: then he put forth his hand, and took her, and pulled her in unto him into the ark. And he stayed yet other seven days; and again he sent forth the dove out of the ark: And the dove came in to him in the **evenina**; and, lo, in her mouth was an **olive** leaf pluckt off: so Noah knew that the waters were abated from off the earth. And he stayed yet other seven days; and sent forth the dove; which returned not again unto him any more.



5. THE TOWER OF BABEL GENESIS 11:1-9

And the whole earth was of one language, and of one speech. And it came to pass, as they journeyed from the east, that they found a plain in the land of **Shinar**: and they dwelt there. And they said one to another, Go to, let us make **brick**, and burn them thoroughly. And they had brick for stone, and slime had they for morter. And they said, Go to, let us build us a city and a tower, whose top may reach unto heaven; and let us make us a name, lest we be scattered abroad upon the face of the whole earth. And the Lord came **down** to see the city and the tower, which the children of men builded. And the LORD said, Behold, the people is one, and they have all **one** language; and this they begin to do: and now nothing will be restrained from them, which they have imagined to do. Go to, let us go down, and there confound their language, that they may not understand one another's speech. So the LORD **scattered** them abroad from thence upon the face of all the earth: and they left off to build the **city**. Therefore is the **name** of it called **Babel**: because the LORD did there confound the language of all the earth: and from thence did the LORD scatter them abroad upon the face of all the earth.




6. TWO (ITIES COMPLETELY DESTROYED GENESIS 19:15-30

ACROSS


